### CCABC Constitution & Bylaws 14.2 –

#### Membership in the Association shall consist of five categories:

- a) **Regular:** Any individual operator of a Place of Interment or a Crematorium.
- b) **Supplier:** Any memorial dealer, company, organization or individual that provides goods or services to places of interment, crematoriums and their operators, employees or clients.
- c) **Individual:** Any individual not qualified for regular membership, but is associated with a regular or supplier member, or is retired from the cemetery and crematorium profession.
- d) **Associate:** Any company, organization or individual concerned with the provision of death care services and whose interest is to advance the objectives of the CCABC.
- e) **Honorary:** Any individual who, subject to the discretion of the Board of Directors, it is deemed desirable and appropriate to honor for their contribution made to the CCABC and to cemetery and cremation service in general.

Only Regular Members in good standing shall have full voice in the affairs of the Corporation including the right to vote, to nominate, to be nominated and to be elected to an Officer position.

Membership of a company, local government, institution or other entity that operate a division, group or multiple locations engaged in the provision of cemetery and cremation services, or are suppliers to cemetery and cremation service providers, shall be in accordance with criteria established by the Board.

At no time shall the number of non-voting members exceed the number of voting members of the Association. Only regular members in good standing and in attendance at the Annual General Meeting shall be permitted to vote. Only proxy votes submitted as per article 12.2 of these bylaws shall be recognized as valid for inclusion in voting that occurs at the Annual General Meeting. Proxy voting shall not be permitted from the floor of the Annual General Meeting.
